Lego Lab Lesson – How Farm Animals Live (45 minutes)

<u>Learning Goal</u>: I will be able to sort farm animals and build a habitat for the animals.

Learning Activity: My team and I will sort the farm animals according to types of animals (babies matching mommy animals). Once the animals are matched we will build their habitat on the farm.

Don't forget that you can use the pre test prior to coming to the Lego lab as well as the post test when you go back to your classroom. We do encourage you to use these tools as a way to track learning in the lab. You will want to group students in 4 groups.

The story is on farm animals and the book is The Petting Farm Poster Book by Lisa Hiley. This is a poster book that you may use to show pictures of farm animals and not read so much. You may find the book located in the Lego Lab. There isn't enough time to read the entire story, but if you want to look the story up online or just go through the book while in the Lego Lab then that is fine. PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE THE BOOK FROM THE LAB AS IT IS CHECKED OUT TO ME OR SUSAN!! I don't want to pay for any lost books!

Suggested delivery of lesson: (gauge your time to allow most time for building)

- Go over learning goal
- Read the card for the week
- Read the story (go through pages depending on how long the book is)
- Allow students to build
