

# TRAVEL OPTIONS DURING METRO IMPROVEMENTS

**FEBRUARY 11 - APRIL 12, 2017**

- The Washington, DC Metrorail will conduct system-wide improvements through June 2017 that will cause service delays. This initiative is called SafeTrack.
- The highest period of impact to Alexandria is February 11 through April 12, 2017.
- Fortunately, there are many convenient ways to travel the seven miles between Washington and Alexandria. On the next page is a quick summary of our favorite options, including the most convenient routes to and from Washington, DC.

## SERVICE IMPACT SCHEDULE

*\*SUBJECT TO CHANGE*

- Now through April 12: Blue and Yellow Line trains are operating but only every 24-30 minutes due to single tracking. Consider alternative transportation between Alexandria and DC or Reagan National Airport, especially during peak travel hours.
- On Friday, March 24 and Wednesday, April 12, buses may replace Metrorail trains after 8 PM.
