- 3:00pm After lunch you'll hop on a pontoon boat at the Fourwinds Marina and be whisked off on a boat towards the Paynetown State Recreation Area, on your way to the Fire Tower, 5 miles in to the Deam Wilderness Area of the HoosierNational Forest. Keep your eyes open for bald eagles, as this area is one of their natural habitats.

3:45pm **CLIMB THE FIRE TOWER AT THE HOOSIER NATIONAL FOREST**
- 4:45pm It's totally worth the 162 step climb to the top of the Fire Tower, where sweeping 360 degree views of the rolling hills of South Central Indiana will take your breath away.
