The Communications Manager is responsible for oversight of all content planning, tracking, monitoring and reporting. Tasks include research, analytics, collaboration with the partnership department, content creation for VisitBucksCounty.com, industry e-newsletters and collateral pieces. An ideal candidate is an extremely organized thinker and doer with a strong knowledge of Bucks County tourism trends and digital implementation.

Pay Rate: Commensurate with experience; full-time (40 hours per week) salaried position.

Major Responsibilities:

The responsibilities for this position include, but are not limited to:

Content:

- Collaborates with Marketing Director to develop and manage content calendar organizing web, e-news, public relations, digital assets (photo and video), social, calendar of events and advertising content.
- Works closely with partnership department on brainstorming content ideas based on the calendar of events, partnering and packaging meetings, etc. and updates content calendar accordingly.
- Manages content management system for VisitBucksCounty.com posting all content, articles, photo and video to the site.
- Ensures all content remains fresh and easily accessible on VisitBucksCounty.com.
- Writes content for VisitBucksCounty.com.
- Stays up-to-date with trends and monitors internal statistics to proactively change the digital content strategy when necessary.
- Monitors Google Analytics on a consistent basis and reports to staff on traffic and trends; monitors the web for accuracy and makes updates based on reporting.

Social Media:

- Posts, engages and curates digital content for Visit Bucks County's Facebook channel. Manages social content calendar for this platform and collaborates with staff on topics, timing and reporting.
- Monitors Facebook, trends and provides tactical and strategic recommendations.
- Manages social media trends across all platforms and management plans for new channels including Snapchat.
- Manages social media tracking reports collaborating with Content Manager and PR Manager.

E-Newsletters/Collateral:

- Manages the schedule, production and distribution of e-newsletters for all markets.
- Tracks and reports on e-newsletter distribution statistics and other related items.
- Supports Marketing Director and staff by managing various digital and print projects, including one sheets, promotional materials, signage and tradeshow collateral/coordination.

Internship Program:

- Manages the intern recruitment process, including posting job descriptions to various college databases, filtering applications, scheduling and hosting interviews and administering writing tests.
- Assists in managing interns, including scheduling days of work, updating list of projects, reading/editing all work, assigning projects and other related tasks.
- Performs other tasks as required.
