YEAR-END STATS

Growth in hotel occupancy continues (for the past 37 months), with the highest December hotel occupancy since 2005, and the U.S. December's highest Average Daily Rate since 2007. Year-end, ADR is up 3.4% over 2011 at \$114.48 and hotel occupancy is up 3.2% over 2011 at 72.7%.

PORT NEWS

Port Everglades celebrates the grand re-opening for four renovated cruise terminals: Terminals 2, 19, 21 and 26 are part of a \$54 million renovation project that transformed existing facilities into modern, world-class, guest-friendly cruise terminals, capable of processing both debarking and embarking cruise passengers simultaneously. Florida Gov. Rick Scott issued a press release saying that he applauded the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) investment of \$9 million to reconstruct and modernize four cruise terminals at Port Everglades.

FLYING HIGH

Total passenger traffic for December 2012 was 2,147,564, up 2.3% over last year. Domestic traffic was up 2.2% and international traffic was up 2.5%. December marked the 7th consecutive month of positive growth in total traffic and was the busiest December on record. New domestic service for the year included: Airtran to San Juan in May; Alaska Airlines to Seattle in July; Spirit to Baltimore in September and Minneapolis in November; United to Washington Dulles in November; Allegiant to Ashville in November and JetBlue to Providence. Silver Airways started service to Orlando in January and Frontier will begin service to Trenton, NJ in February. New international service by JetBlue to Medellin, Colombia and San Jose, Costa Rica will begin in June. FLL continues to be the domestic airport of choice in South Florida. In 2012, FLL had over one million more available domestic seats than MIA, 28% more domestic destinations, twice the origin and destination domestic passengers, and 20% lower domestic fares.

SPORT LAUDERDALE

Sports Development welcomes more than 25,000 athletes, coaches, and families to Greater Fort Lauderdale in February, attending events such as: the A1A Marathon and Half Marathon and Expo, the Clay Court Classic Tennis Tournament, the Weston Cup Soccer Tournament, and the Columbia vs Guatemala International Soccer Tournament at Sun Life Stadium.

GETTING AROUND

Airport Excursion (operated by Sun Trolley) began service last month. This 13-week pilot program (sponsored by the City of Fort Lauderdale), connects visitors waiting at the airport for their flight home with our downtown community. The program will run until April 7, 2013, every Friday – Sunday, 9am-4pm (last trolley departs downtown at 3:30pm). FREE shuttle from FLL to the Stranahan House “Welcome Center.” Sun Trolley Excursion tickets are then sold on board the bus and onsite at the Welcome Center. \$19.95pp includes round-trip airport transportation, all-day Sun Trolley access, discounted coupons & participating museum entrance fees, \$29.95pp includes all-day Water Taxi pass (plus all items listed above – \$100 VALUE). Passengers can conveniently leave luggage onsite at the airport by Bags To Go, \$6/bag or \$5/bag with Sun Trolley Excursion receipt, bags are not allowed on Sun Trolley buses. Passengers can depart from all four airport terminals (lower, baggage claim level). Visitors can walk outside and wait for the next vehicle which stops hourly at public transportation signs (with Sun Trolley/Tri Rail logos).
