

FLYING HIGH

International traffic has grown 18% at Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport between 2008 and 2012, the latest data show,

thanks to Broward County's diverse population and the airport's success at attracting low-cost carriers with increasingly expanding international service. [Click here to read the full story.](#) Service from Latin America expanded with new flights on JetBlue Airways to Medellin, Colombia and San Jose, Costa Rica and Lima, Peru this December, and begin service to Port of Spain, Trinidad and Tobago (POS) with once daily non-stop flights set to begin May 1, 2014. And new service from Mexico City by Delta. Twice-weekly flights from Stockholm and Copenhagen begin November 29 and December 1, 2013, respectively on Scandinavian low-cost carrier Norwegian Air Shuttle.

KOSHER FOOD BEFORE FLYING

For the first time, kosher meals have been rolled out at the FLL airport in Terminal 3. The salads, sandwiches and baked goods are marketed under the label of red hot Chef Allen Susser. Hollywood-based Kosher Central Market will source, prepare and certify the meals that will be delivered to Susser's airport concession. DINOSAURS IN MOTION

Visitors will have the ability to manipulate dinosaurs via lever and pulley systems, as well as with remote controls, offering large-scale dinosaur interaction unprecedented in a museum setting. STREETSCAPES IN LAUDERDALE-BY-THE-SEA

Construction of two innovative streetscape projects are underway at Lauderdale-By-The-Sea. The Town's plan to revitalize the business district on Commercial Boulevard includes widening sidewalks and adding lush foliage. The goal is to make strolling through the Town more enjoyable, create beautiful public plazas and provide for additional open-air dining. To facilitate parking during construction, free parking is available in the Town's A1A lot, just north of Commercial Blvd. on the west side of the road. And, a new 78-space lot was recently opened near the ocean on El Mar Drive and A1A within a block of downtown.
